	<p><b>All participants take part in the discussion.</b></p> <p>Discussion will focus on the potential of RRI to address societal challenges and societal transformation processes; drivers and barriers; role of leadership and local R&amp;I stakeholders for steering transformation to public benefit; reconciling citizen perspectives and expected policy impacts; in which contexts can RRI be most suitably applied.</p> <p><b>Beginning:</b> Each territorial partner (or stakeholder from each territory) makes a short 3-minute introduction to their city, giving one or two examples where RRI-AIRR has helped tackle a challenge.</p> <p><b>Discussion questions</b> (indicative list):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is your perception of responsible territorial governance?</li> <li>• What is the major problem and/or challenge where you think RRI-AIRR can make a big difference for the future of your city? How can you make this happen?</li> <li>• What is the added value of incorporating the RRI-AIRR framework into your policymaking?</li> <li>• Are RRI dimensions conducive to better governance and impact of the local R&amp;I system?</li> <li>• What kind of leadership characteristics are needed for the implementation of the RRI framework in policy making?</li> <li>• What place for citizens in future policy-making?</li> </ul> <p><b>Conclusion:</b> Each territorial partner prepares to conclude in <u>1 min</u> on the following branching out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do you think or expect your approach to RRI-AIRR as a city can inspire other cities and citizens and what for (related to your policy area and beyond)?</li> </ul>
